ADVANCING INNOVATION

At CureSearch, we take an entrepreneurial approach by funding the very best research that will dramatically accelerate our ability to end children's cancer.

CureSearch Catapult is a new, paradigm-changing strategy to expedite promising research to commercialization of pediatric cancer treatments. CureSearch is proud to work with key partners to catapult the best research into clinical application, ultimately ensuring children receive better treatments faster.

The Acceleration Initiative (AI) is our \$10 million commitment to surface the most promising children's cancer research, to drive it to clinical practice, and to quickly find better treatments and cures.

The Young Investigator Program provides significant financial support to investigators early in their research careers. Early-career investigators are the most vulnerable to federal funding shortages, and they rely heavily on the support of private foundations like CureSearch to continue their research.

CureSearch Community Impact Awards (CCIA) were created to recognize the importance of local hospital care in addressing the immediate needs of childhood cancer patients and their families. CCIA funds help doctors, nurses, child life specialists, and social workers and other medical professionals dedicated to caring for children with cancer. Awards are used for psycho-social resources and professional training, and pilot early-phase clinical trials.

25 new drugs in preclinical testing for high-risk brain cancer, sarcoma, leukemia and Wilms tumor

300+ potential new drug targets being studied for **9** types of children's cancer

1 novel drug for Ewing sarcoma nearing pediatric clinical trials

3 clinical trials for late effects and adolescent/young adult transition


CURESEARCH SUPERHEROES UNITE!


